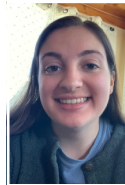

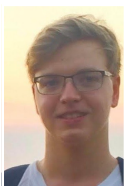

Frontline workers in the Pioneer Valley area lack the basic safety equipment they desperately need during the COVID-19 crisis. Seeing this need, Academy Hill alumni, Mathieu Johnson, and Stephen Cooley donated their time and experience to fabricate face shields.

Mathieu, AHS class of 2017, having an extensive amount of experience with 3-D printing, started a GoFundMe page to raise the necessary funds to buy supplies in order to 3-D print the face shields. His goal is to print 2,000 face shields to those in need.

Stephen Cooley, AHS class of 2019, in conjunction with his new school, Deerfield Academy, 3D-printed face shields to distribute to frontline workers in need. A face shield reduces exposure by protecting frontline workers from airborne droplets, spray, and fluids. Way to go, Mathieu and Stephen!
